Itinerary Details

Mystic Iceland - Sum 2024

7Nights 8Days



Day 1 : Welcome to Reykjavik – the beautiful Capital of Iceland.



Dinner

Welcome to Reykjavik. Get transferred to your conveniently located hotel. (Check-in on your own after 15:00). The rest of the day is at leisure to explore the city on your own. Overnight in Reykjavik. (Dinner)

Day 2 : Get mesmerized with the Tour of the Golden Circle – visit Thingvellir National Park, Geyser hot springs and Gullfoss waterfall.



Breakfast, Dinner

Today, visit three of Iceland's most famous spots: Thingvellir National Park, Geyser hot springs and Gullfoss waterfall. Start the day at the ancient Viking Parliament area of Thingvellir National Park, a UNESCO world heritage site. The Thingvellir plain is situated on a tectonic-plate boundary where North America and Europe are slowly tearing away from each other. Next stop is at the Geysir geo-thermal fields with a variety of hot springs and bubbling pools. Gullfoss, "the golden falls", is a double waterfall that tumbles 34 meters into the Hvítá river originating from the glacier Langjökull. We arrive into Vik – a remote seaside town in south Iceland Overnight in Vik or similar. (Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 3 : Visit scenic South Iceland – black volcanic beach at Reynisfjara, Skógafoss, glaciers of Mýrdalsjökull and a volcano Eyjafjallajökull.

Today, drive along the south coast of Iceland, one of the country's most scenic regions. Visit the spectacular Skógafoss - considered one of Iceland's biggest and most beautiful waterfalls. See the Sólheimasandur plane wreck site – made famous in Bollywood movies. We will stop at Reynisfjara black sand beach, with the Reynisdrangar rock formations and columnar basalt. See the glaciers of Mýrdalsjökull – which hides the Kalta Volcano in its depth, and the infamous volcano Eyjafjallajökull - has been an internationally renowned landmark ever since it erupted in 2010, stopping all air traffic with its gigantic ash plume. Overnight in Vik or similar. (Breakfast/ Dinner)

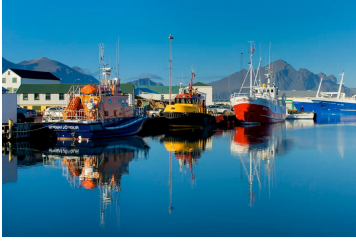
Day 4 : Visit Iceland's largest glacier - Vatnajökull National Park – including Skaftafell and Jökulsárlón Glacier.

Today, we proceed to Vatnajökull National Park - Iceland's largest glacier and witness plenty of its outlet glaciers cascading to the lowland. Skaftafell is a nature reserve located in Vatnajökull National Park in the Southeast of Iceland. Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon belongs to the Vatnajökull glacier. Huge blocks of ice (more than 1,000 years old) are continually breaking from it and large chunks of iceberg float in the lagoon. The ice-chunks take on so many forms and colours, ranging from transparent, to white, to the most amazing blue colour - some of the ice is black, it is like visiting an art gallery. Enjoy an amphibian boat tour at the Jökulsárlón-Glacier Lagoon. Later we arrive into Hofn – a fishing town in the southeastern part of Iceland. Overnight in Hofn. (Breakfast/ Dinner)

Day 5 : Onto Akureyri – See the mysterious Ásbyrgi Canyon.

Today morning proceed to Ásbyrgi - glacial canyon and forest in the north of Iceland. Visit Ásbyrgi Canyon, a spectacular horseshoe-shaped depression in the northeast of Iceland. Later we proceed to Akureyri - a city at the base of Eyjafjörður Fjord in northern Iceland. Overnight in Akureyri. (Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 6 : Langjökull

Today we visit Langjökull – the second largest ice cap in Iceland. This is your opportunity to experience it in the most amazing way possible, by doing it in a Super Jeep in a large, modified, mountain-ready vehicle to Langjökull glacier! Walk around to the largest man-made Ice Cave in the world made into the famous Langjökull glacier. Overnight in Reykholt. (Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 7 : Enjoy the colours of the city on a guided tour of Reykjavik the beautiful capital of Island with Arbaer Open Air Museum. Experience Blue Lagoon – Thermal Spa.



Today morning we head towards the capital city – Reykjavik. Visit the most important places of Reykjavík, including the famous Hallgrímskirkja church, named after the 17th-century poet and clergyman Hallgrímur Pétursson. Enjoy a visit to Árbær Open Air Museum - the historical museum. Afternoon enjoy the world-famous Blue Lagoon. Experience the tranquillity of the unique Geothermal Milky Blue Sea waters, considered by many to be a once-in-a-lifetime experience and an unmissable part of your Iceland Holiday. The Blue Lagoon was formed in 1976 during an operation at the nearby geothermal power plant. In the years that followed, people began to bathe in the water and apply the silica mud to their skin. It's known for its restorative qualities and health benefits. The Blue Lagoon is surrounded by a mossy lava field, offering incredible scenery, with state-of-the-art facilities and an other-worldly atmosphere. Overnight in Reykjavik. (Breakfast/Dinner)
