Day 1 : Welcome to Paris - the City of Lights and Glamour.

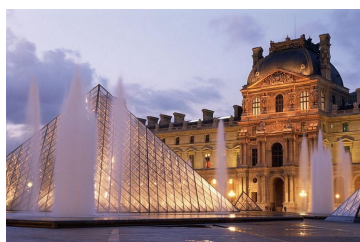
Day 2 : Enjoy a guided city tour of Paris. Visit the world-renowned Louvre Museum. Take in a bird's eye view of Paris from the Eiffel Tower's 02 Level. Enjoy a romantic cruise on the River Seine.



Today proceed on a fascinating guided city tour of Paris. Marvel at the finest Parisian sights – the Champs Elysees, Alexander Bridge, Invalides, Arc de Triomphe, Concorde Square, Opera House and several others. Visit the world-renowned Louvre Museum (No Guide), known for its collection of artifacts and paintings and see the enigmatic smile of 'Mona Lisa', Leonardo da Vinci's masterpiece. Visit the iconic Eiffel Tower for a stunning view of the city from the 2nd level. Later enjoy a romantic cruise down the River Seine. Day 3 : Onto Switzerland.

Today proceed on a scenic drive to Switzerland - home to numerous lakes, villages and the high peaks of the Alps. The country is also known for its ski resorts and hiking trails. Banking and finance are key industries, while Swiss watches and chocolates are world-renowned. Overnight in Central Switzerland. (Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 4 : Visit Mt. Titlis, take an exciting ride up the snow-clad Swiss Alps in Rotair – the world's first rotating cable car. Visit the most beautiful city of Lucerne.



Today, view the massive mountain peaks and glacier crevasses on Mt. Titlis from the world's first revolving cable car - Rotair. Mt. Titlis is central Switzerland's loftiest peak, covered with snow and ice and a visual treat. At 10,000 feet, get an unrestricted 360-degree view of the Alpine landscape. Experience the TITLIS Cliff Walk – the highest suspension bridge in Europe. Later, drive on to one of the most beautiful cities in Switzerland - Lucerne. View the Lion Monument and the Kapellbrücke (wooden bridge). Enjoy some free time to shop for famous Swiss watches, knives, souvenirs, and chocolates. Overnight in Central Switzerland. (Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 5 : Day free OR you can opt for an excursion to the Magical Alpine wonderland of Jungfrauoch.

Today the day is free to explore the city on your own OR opt for the magical Alpine

excursion to Jungfrauoch - the Top of Europe. Board a cogwheel train to reach the highest railway station in Europe at 11,333 feet, to an Alpine wonderland of ice and snow. Visit Ice Palace, experience a breathtaking panoramic view from the Sphinx Observation Terrace and view the longest glacier in the Alps - the Aletsch Glacier. Overnight in Central Switzerland. (Breakfast/Packed Dinner)

Day 6 : Visit Swarovski Crystal Museum – the dazzling world of crystals. Visit the beautiful city of Innsbruck.

Today morning proceed to Wattens, to visit the Swarovski World of Crystals and marvel at the crystalline works of art. Drive to Innsbruck for an orientation tour of this beautiful city. See the Golden Roof with its gold-plated copper tiles, a characteristic landmark of Innsbruck, walk down cobblestone pathways of Maria Theresien Strasse and relive the medieval European culture. The splendid Alps in the background provide a perfect picture-postcard setting. Overnight in Austria. (Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 7 : Visit romantic Venice, a lagoon city that inspired poetry and passion.

This morning proceed towards Italy, arrive at the pier in Venice, where we board a boat and sail to St. Mark's Square – the main square of Venice, where the only traffic is that of humans and pigeons! The famed Bell Tower and the Clock Tower, display not only the time, but also the dominant sign of the Zodiac and the current phase of the moon. Continue to the Bridge of Sighs, made of white limestone, that passes over the Rio di Palazzo, connecting the old prisons with interrogation rooms at the Doge's Palace. Overnight in Padova / Occhiobello or similar. (Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 8 : All roads lead to Rome – the eternal city.

Proceed towards the eternal city of Rome. Sit back to your luxurious coach and enjoy the scenic route and the picturesque landscape of Italy. Overnight in Rome. (Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 9 : Guided City tour of Rome. Visit the world's smallest country – the Vatican City.



Enjoy a guided city tour of Rome with an expert English- speaking local guide. View the divinely beautiful basilica of St. Peter's. We walk around the city to view the magnificent Colosseum, a vast amphitheater that is still well preserved. Later walk to the beautiful Trevi Fountains – The Legend goes that tossing a coin over your shoulder gets you back to Rome. We continue towards the Victor Emmanuel Monument, the Roman Forum, and take several more sights of this remarkable city. Next visit the Vatican City – the smallest country in the world (note: shorts or sleeveless vests not allowed). Enter the Vatican Museum, where you see the renowned classical sculptures and masterpieces of the Renaissance Art. Visit the famed Sistine Chapel - a source of inspiration for art lovers and tourists alike and

known for its masterpiece - the Last Judgement. Overnight in the Tuscany Region.

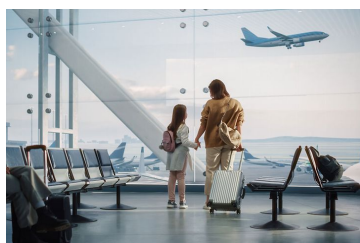
Day 10 : Guided city tour of Florence. View the remarkable and famous Leaning Tower of Pisa.



Today drive to Florence – the cradle of the Renaissance. Start your walking tour of Florence along with your English speaking local guide, absorb the culture with a tour of the historic city. View the Duomo - the city's most iconic landmark, the Campanile, the Baptistery with its Gates to Paradise. See Piazza Della Signoria – an open-air museum crammed with Renaissance sculptures, edged by historic cafes and presided over by the magnificent Palazzo Vecchio. See the famed Ponte Vecchio (bridge) across the River Arno. Next, drive to Piazzale Michelangelo to get a spectacular city panorama view. Finally, proceed onwards to Pisa – the Square of Miracles and see the remarkable Leaning Tower of Pisa. Proceed to Milan, the fashion capital of the world. Orientation tour of Milan. Overnight in the Milan.

After checkout from the hotel, proceed for a wonderful journey of Lake Como. Lake Como is one of the biggest lakes with a surface of 145 sq km and the deepest lake in Europe with a depth of 410 m. It is located in the northern region of Italy. The lake has a bizarre “Y” shape with three extremities: the northern with Colico, the southeast with Lecco and the southwest with Como. A wonderful holiday gracefully ends with this picture perfect journey. Depart for the airport for your return /onward flight. (Breakfast)
