Day 1 : Welcome to Berlin – Capital of Germany.

Welcome to Berlin – capital and largest city of Germany. Meet your friendly Travel Professional outside the baggage hall and proceed to our hotel. (Check-in after 1500 hrs.). Overnight in Berlin. (Dinner)

Day 2 : Familiarize with Berlin on a guided city tour as you visit the Berlin Wall.

Embark on a guided city tour of Berlin. The city is an immaculate blend of deep history, modern flair, and multi-cultural influences. Visit “Check Point Charlie” and the remnants of the infamous Berlin Wall which today stands as the East Side Gallery. Drive on the Unter den Linden, a boulevard named after the linden i.e. lime trees and arrive at the majestic Brandenburg Gate. Visit Alexanderplatz, one of the most famous squares in Berlin to observe the World time clock. See the imposing Reichstag with its dome. Reichstag is the seat of the German parliament and one of Berlin's most historic landmarks. This afternoon we will proceed for a trip outside Berlin to historic Potsdam. The city, which is over 1,000 years old, is widely known for its palaces, its lakes, and its overall historical and cultural significance Return to Berlin. Overnight in Berlin. Day 3 : Visit Prague – Capital of the Czech Republic. Enjoy a guided city tour of Dresden.

Today we drive to the Capital city of The Czech Republic – Prague. The city of a Hundred Spires, a UNESCO monument and is one of the most beautiful cities in the world. Prague is said to be as beautiful as the city of Paris. Enroute, enjoy a guided tour of Dresden, situated on the banks of The Elba river and dubbed as “Florence of the East”. See the Semper Opera House, The Royal Courtyard of Zwinger Palace & the 18th Century Cathedral. Continue your journey to Prague. Overnight in Prague. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 4 : Enjoy a guided tour of Prague Castle.

Proceed on a walking tour with our guide of this Fairy Tale city - Prague. Visit the remarkable Hradcany Castle, which is said to be the biggest castle in the world at about 570 meters long and about 130 meters wide. See the St. Vitus Cathedral, the seat of the Archbishop of Prague. View the magnificent Charles bridge decorated by a continuous alley of statues, in the Baroque-style. Arrive in the Old town square to witness the unique walk of the apostles at the Astronomical Clock. See Wenceslas Square - center of the business and cultural communities, and the Jewish Quarter, the smallest cadastral area of Prague. This afternoon, take a relaxing cruise on the beautiful River Vltava and you'll find out about the legends, myths, culture and hidden secrets of this enchanting city. Overnight in Prague. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 5 : Drive to Krakow – Excursion to the camps of Auschwitz

Absorb yourself in the picturesque route to Poland. On arrival in Poland embark on a poignant journey through history as you travel to witness the former concentration camps of Auschwitz. Experience the melancholy as you learn about the account of the resilience of the human spirit that occurred within those walls. Later we proceed to Krakow – a city known for its well-preserved medieval core and Jewish quarter. Overnight in Krakow. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 6 : Guided city tour of Krakow – Wieliczka Salt Mines

Meet a local guide to discover Krakow's Old town on a city tour featuring Market square, St. Mary's church, and Wawel Castel - a former place of residence of the Polish kin gs and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Later take a fascinating guided tour of the “Wieliczka Salt Mines” one of the most valuable monuments of material and spiritual culture in Poland. Wieliczka Salt Mine is visited by tourists every day, showing the most amazing works of art sculpted throughout the many centuries of laborious miners' work. Overnight in Krakow. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 7 : Onto Hungary – Budapest. Enroute enjoy an orientation tour of Bratislava.

Drive to Budapest - the Capital of Hungary. Enroute, enjoy an orientation tour of Bratislava. Walk down the Old Town, St. Martin's Cathedral, Michael's Gate, Churches, Palaces of famous families, Slovak National Theatre and more. Proceed to Budapest. This evening, enjoy a culture extravaganza – the famous Hungarian Folklore show – with traditional music and dance Overnight in Budapest. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 8 : Guided city tour of Budapest. Enjoy cruising down the River Danube. Enjoy the folklore show.

With your local guide enjoy a guided city tour. Visit the Fisherman's Bastion, Szechenyi Chain Bridge, and Buda Castle. Drive on the Andrassy Boulevard and arrive at the majestic Hero 's Square featuring the Magyars Chieftains and diverse leaders of Hungary. Take a tour of the Hungarian Parliament Building which has nearly 700 rooms with its ceremonial staircase, ceiling frescoes & 16- sided hall below the dome. In the evening take a memorable cruise on the River Danube enjoying the impressive views of the city. Overnight in Budapest. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 9 : Onto Zagreb – See the vast Lake Balaton

Today we proceed to Zagreb – the colorful capital of Croatia. En route we enjoy a photo stop on the shores of Lake Balaton, the largest lake in Central Europe and affectionately known by locals as the 'Hungarian Sea'. A bronze bust of Rabindranath Tagore is located on the Tagore Promenade in Balatonfüred. Meet the local guide and get introduced to the thousand-year-old history of Zagreb. Visit the Gornji Grad (Upper Town), location of the Croatian Parliament, and the St. Mark's Church - the parish church of old Zagreb. With its artistic composition and the number of statues, this portal is the richest and the most valuable Gothic portal in southern Central Europe. The Donji Grad – Lower town is in the central part of the city Overnight in Zagreb (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 10 : Visit Plitvice National Park

Travel south across the Croatian border to the exquisite Plitvice Lakes National Park – a UNESCO World Heritage site. - As you absorb the irresistible beauty of many lower lakes and caves that are all magically connected by waterfalls, you'll see first-hand why this is justifiably one of Croatia's most beloved places and an important natural treasure that deserves to be preserved for generations to come. Overnight in Zagreb (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 11 : Drive to the scenic Lake Bled. Visit Ljubljana

Today drive to Ljubljana the capital of Slovenia. Embark on a guided walking tour to see the Old town. See the baroque cathedral of St. Nicholas, an easily recognizable landmark of the city with its green dome and twin towers. Cross the Cobblers Bridge, one of the oldest bridges crossing the river in Ljubljana and Triple Bridge, which is also probably the city's most unusual and the most frequently crossed bridge. It connects the main square and a newer part of the town with the Old Town. Later we proceed to Lake Bled- a lake in the Julian Alps of the Upper Carniolan region of northwestern Slovenia. It is 2120 m long, up to 1380 m wide. It is also termed as the "Paradise on Earth". Overnight in Lake Bled. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 12 : Drive to the scenic Lake Bled. Enjoy a scenic boat ride.

Enjoy an orientation tour of the Lake Bled. Take a pleasurable ride in a traditional, flat-bottom wooden boat with a pointed bow and the stern widened. Onto Vienna – the city of Music – the imperial Capital of Austria. Overnight in Vienna. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 13 : Guided City tour of Vienna with visit to Schönbrunn Palace

Today we proceed for a guided tour of this imperial city – see the iconic sights - the Opera House, Parliament, St. Stephen's Cathedral and the 13th-century Hofburg Palace, at the heart of Vienna. Visit the Schönbrunn Palace. It was the main summer residence of the Habsburg rulers, located in Hietzing, the 13th district of Vienna. The name Schönbrunn has its roots in an artesian well from which water was consumed by the court. Overnight in Vienna. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)
