## **Day 1 : Welcome to Victoria Falls – one of the world's largest waterfalls.**

Later proceed towards Cape Point, and the Cape of Good Hope said to be the romantic meeting place of the two mighty oceans, the Atlantic and the Indian. Overnight in Cape Town.
