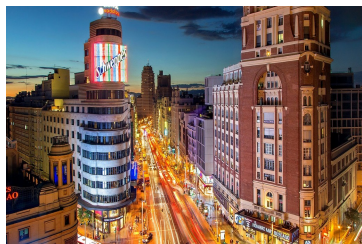

Day 1 : Madrid - The Spain's cultural capital city

Welcome to Madrid - the Spanish Capital! Meet your friendly Travel Professional outside the baggage hall and proceed to your conveniently located hotel. (Check-in after 1500 hrs.).

Day 2 : Enjoy a guided city tour of Madrid – Take an orientation tour of the historic city of Toledo and visit the Sword factory.

Today proceed on a guided city tour of Madrid. See Plaza Mayor and Plaza de la Villa - two of the town's main squares. Then visit the Royal Palace (subject to availability). The Royal Palace is the official residence of the Spanish Royal Family, but it is now only used for state ceremonies. See the Las Ventas Bullring. Relive the nostalgia of the 1982 FIFA World Cup final live on your visual screens as you view the world's most famous football venue the Santiago Bernabeu stadium. Later proceed to Toledo for an orientation tour of this imperial city. Toledo was the former capital of Spain. Toledo's Old Town is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Its historical heritage is unparalleled. Later visit the Sword factory known for its bladed weapons. Drive back to Madrid. Overnight in Madrid. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 3 : Enjoy a Scenic drive to Lisbon - Portugal's hilly, coastal capital city.

Day 5 : Visit Seville the Capital of Andalusia. Experience a cruise on River Guadalquivir.

Drive to Seville - Spain's fourth largest city and the capital of Andalusia. Proceed on a city tour of Seville conducted by a local guide. Visit the largest and highest cathedral in Spain. Also see the Giralda, adjacent to the cathedral, a splendid example of Moorish art and now a symbol of Seville. Enjoy some time to stroll along the busy Santa Cruz quarter. The wonderful exploration journey of Seville ends with



a boat cruise on the mystic waters of River Guadalquivir. As you cruise along the mystic river, watch and admire the mesmerizing panoramic view of the city. Overnight in Seville. (Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 6 : Day trip to Cordoba. Guided city tour of Cordoba. Enjoy the Flamenco Show.

Later continue to drive to Granada located on the foothills of the Sierra Nevada Mountains. It is a city of intriguing history and admirable beauty. Overnight in Granada. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

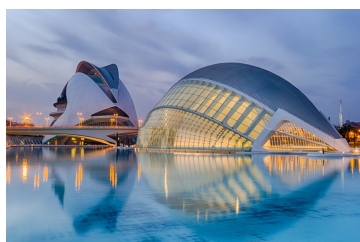
Day 8 : Orientation tour of Granada with entrance to Alhambra Palace (subject to availability).
